

Certified Recovery Residence Administrator (CRRA)

Description of a Certified Recovery Resident Administrator (CRRA):

The CRRA is the person responsible for the overall management of the Recovery Residence; supervision of residents and paid or volunteer staff; ensuring appropriate response to resident needs and maintenance of the residence. The CRRA accomplishes these goals being accountable for implementation of and compliance with the National Alliance of Recovery Residences (NARR) Quality Standards and Code of Ethics for Level 1 - 4 Recovery Residences, or equivalent nationally recognized standards and code of ethics pursuant to 397.487, Florida Statutes. Individuals certified in the field of recovery residence administration have demonstrated competency in five (5) performance domains:

1. Recovery Residence Operations and Administration
2. Maintaining the Physical Residence
3. Resident Screening and Admissions
4. Resident Recovery Support
5. Legal, Professional and Ethical Responsibilities
