Description of a Certified Recovery Support Specialist (CRSS):

The CRSS designation is an entry-level substance abuse credential for person's who use their lived experience to assist clients achieve and maintain recovery from addictions. The CRSS requires a minimum of a high school diploma or general equivalency degree and demonstrated competency through training and experience in the performance Domains of:

- Legal and Professional Responsibility
- Reengagement, Crisis Support & Safety
- Resource Linkage/Follow-up
- Practical Living Skills/Social Development

Recovery Management Individuals holding the CRSS credential have meet all FCB administrative requirements and all credential specific standards and eligibility requirements that have been established for the credential.
